**1.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER**

**i. COMPLETION PERIOD**

The completion period for the balance works is 02 months from the date of issue of letter of intent.

**ii. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)**

- (a) All the tenders/bids must be accompanied by Earnest Money in the form of a Demand Draft or payment through online mode or a Bank Guarantee of any Nationalized / Scheduled Bank drawn as per the BG format of BSHPC.
- (b) Technical Bids of only those bidders who have submitted EMD of the requisite amount shall be opened.
- (c) Public Sector undertaking fully owned by the Bihar Government/ Central Government/other State Governments shall be exempted from

depositing Earnest Money, provided that a certificate of Government Ownership is submitted.

- (d) Unsuccessful Bidder's Earnest Money shall be refunded within 30 (Thirty) days of the award of Contract/issue of LOI to the successful bidder.
- (e) The successful bidder's earnest money will be refunded after receipt of full Performance Security and signing the contract.
- (f) The earnest money may be forfeited, if the successful bidder fails to sign the contract agreement within 30 (Thirty) days of issue of Letter of Intent.

**iii. SITE VISIT**

Before submitting the offer, bidders are required to visit the project site to get them selves fully acquainted with actual site conditions and have complete idea of the scope of balance works. After uploading tender, no claim will be entertained for the same.

**iv. TENDER COST**

The cost (Non-refundable) of tender documents for the work is Rs.10,000.00 which are to be paid to Bihar State Hydroelectric Power Corporation Ltd., Patna through e-payment mode (i.e. NEFT/RTGS/Net banking) credit card/ debit card in Rupees).

**vi. QUALIFYING CRITERIA**

Qualifying criteria for e-tender is open to all Companies / Corporations / limited concerns/ registered firms/reputed contractors who meet with the following qualifying criteria:

- i) The bidders who have experience of Construction of Small Hydro Project.

Or

Have experience in developing, constructing & commissioning of such Small Hydro Power Projects.

Or

Have experience in the infrastructure development
- ii) The bidders should be registered under the Indian Companies Act or under the laws of Bihar State or equivalent within legal framework of State/Govt. of India.
- iii) The bidder should be registered under EPF and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 with EPF, IT, Labour and GST Departments etc.
- iv) The bidder must have executed similar works of contract value of Rs. 1.00 Cr. (Rs. One crore) or more during last 10 years in hydro-power sector / infrastructure development. The end date reckoned as the date of submission of Tender. Bidder must furnish the completion certificate in support of their claim.
- v) Bids should be kept valid for acceptance for a period of 180 (one hundred eighty) days from the day bids are opened. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected.
- vi) (a) Net worth of the bidder should be positive for the each of the last 3 FY as per audited financial reports.  
(b) MAAT (Minimum Average Annual Turnover) should be Rs. 50.00 Lac. taken best 3 years of last 5 FY as per audited financial reports.
- vii) The bidder should not be a blacklisted contractor/company by BSHPCL, Bihar Govt. / State Electricity Board/ Power Distribution Company of State Governments or any department of any State or Government of India.
- viii) The bidders may enter into JV/ Consortium arrangement with one or more parties with minimum 26% share for each of partners.
- ix) One of the JV Partners must meet the “Technical Qualification Criteria”. The other partner/partners shall be exempt from (i) and (iv) of the “Qualifying criteria”. However, each of the partners must be positive networth during the preceding three financial years.
- x) Each partner of Joint Venture/Consortium shall fulfill the financial qualifying criteria in ratio of their respective stake made in Joint Venture.
- xi) All statutory deductions i.e. Income Tax, GST, Seignorage Fee and Royalty will be deducted as per rule from the contractors bill.

- xii) In case of more than one successful bidders having same minimum quoted rate, successful bidder will be decided by lottery system as per guide line of Bihar PWD code.

**vii. SUBMISSION OF TENDER**

1. The bidder shall submit his bid/tender on e-Procurement platform at [www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in](http://www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in).
2. The bidder must have the Class II/III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) with signing + Encryption, and User-id of the e-Procurement website before participating in the e-Tendering process. The bidder may use their DSC if they already have. They can also take DSC from any of the authorized agencies. For user-id they have to get registered themselves on e-procurement website [www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in](http://www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in) and submit their bids online on the same. Offline bids shall not be entertained by the Tender Inviting Authority for the tenders published in e-procurement platform.
3. The bidders shall submit their eligibility and qualification details, Technical bid, Financial bid etc., in the online standard formats given in e-Procurement web site at the respective stage only. The bidders shall upload the scanned copies of all the relevant certificates, documents etc., in support of their eligibility criteria / technical bids and other certificate /documents in the e-Procurement web site. The bidder shall digitally sign on the supporting statements, documents, certificates, uploaded by him, owning responsibility for their correctness / authenticity. The bidder shall attach all the required documents for the specific tender after uploading the same during the bid submission as per the tender notice and bid document.
4. All the required documents should be attached at the proper place as mentioned in the e-forms otherwise the tender of the bidder will be rejected.
5. Tender Processing Fee (TPF) to be paid through e-Payment mode (i.e. NEFT / RTGS, Credit / Debit Card & Net Banking) only.
6. "Bids along with necessary online payments must be submitted through e- Procurement portal [www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in](http://www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in) before the date and time specified in the NIT/RFP. The department / Tendering Authority doesn't take any responsibility for the delay/Non Submission of Tender/Non Reconciliation of online Payment caused due to Non-availability of Internet Connection, Network Traffic / Holidays or any other reason."
7. The tender opening will be done online only.
8. Any corrigendum or date extension notice will be given on the e-Procurement website only.
9. No claim shall be entertained on account of disruption of internet service being used by bidders. Bidders are advised to upload their bids well in advance to avoid last minute technical snags.
